- Reading: Have your child practice making predictions based on what they knew happened previously in a story.
- Writing: Have your child discover something they are an expert in and would like to teach someone as we move into informational writing.
- Science: Have your child talk about a plant or animal they have seen in Georgia and what habitat and region they believe it lives in.

Continued... **3rd GRADE NEWS** WHAT'S HAPPENING IN... Students will continue to learn about multiplication as equal groups of a number, this week specifically focusing on multiples of ten (ex. 70 x 4=). We will introduce division this week as finding the "how many groups" or the "how many in each group" from our multiplication problems. We will also be highlighting the mathematical vocabulary: multiples, quotient, dividend, divisor, factor, and product. ADVANCED MATH with MS. LESCHER: Our class is continuing to explain Math equivalent fractions in special cases, and compare fractions by reasoning about their size.

ACCELERATED MATH with MS. BLOUNT: Students will start Unit 2 on Monday! They will be working to interpret a multiplication equation as a comparison. They will represent verbal statements of multiplicative comparisons as multiplication equations.

In reading this week, we will begin our spooky mystery unit. Readers will embody their inner detective and learn to stay on high alert for possible hidden clues from the author.

In writing this week, students will become teachers in a new informational unit. This

introduction week will focus in on organization and structure for this new genre. We will structure a table of contents and chapters in their writing for this unit.

The first half of our week will be reviewing five
